Deborah Corsini - Curator, San Jose Museum of Quilts & Textiles

Scope and Eligibility

Celebrating the diversity of contemporary fiber arts, this exhibit will feature a variety of two- and three-dimensional work across the fiber art spectrum, including but not limited to wearables, art quilts, weaving, basketry, beaded work, and felted pieces. Open to all California residents.

Juror

Deborah Corsini is the curator of the San Jose Museum of Quilts & Textiles. In addition, she is a fiber artist and exhibits her graphic wedge weave tapestries internationally.

Rules of Entry

1. All work must be original and executed by the exhibiting artist, completed after January 1, 2006.
2. Jurying will be by digital submissions (see next column), with a maximum of 3 entries per artist. Each entry may include one detail image.
3. Group entries must be represented by individual images from each contributor.
4. All pieces must be ready for hanging and labeled on back with: name, title and year completed.
5. Work requiring special handling must be installed and removed by the artist.
6. Specific work accepted for entry is to be available for the duration of the exhibit. No work may be substituted or removed prior to the end of the show, for any reason.

Payment

1. Nonrefundable entry fees for up to 3 entries:
Non-SCAL members: \$40 / SCAL members: \$30
2. New members are welcome to join by adding dues to entry fee check. Dues are as follows:

Regular	Senior*/Student**	Family***
\$75	\$50	\$125

*Seniors - 62 or older. **Full or part-time students with valid ID.

***Family member must be at same address.

4. Payment by check to be made payable to "SCAL". Cash payments in person only; Visa or MasterCard acceptable with complete account number, expiration date and signature.

Sales / Insurance / Shipping

1. Artist agrees to donate 45% of any sale of work to SCAL or 30% of sale if SCAL member.
2. Artist is to be paid three weeks from end of show.
3. SCAL insures work only after installation. Maximum insured value \$1,000 regardless of price.
4. Shipped entries must have return shipping prepaid and prearranged. Questions? www.fedex.com or www.ups.com.
5. \$20 handling fee per piece for shipped work.

Application Materials

1. Artists may submit up to three entries. An entry is one individual art work. Please include one full view for each entry. One detail view per entry is optional.
2. Images must be in jpg format, submitted on CD.
3. Image size and labeling: Images should be 72 dpi jpgs, no larger than 8" in any direction. Each file must have the artist's last name, initial, image number, (1-3 corresponding with entry form titles), and "full" or "detail." (example: SmithD_1-full.jpg SmithD_1-detail.jpg)
4. Statement describing artwork or process to be submitted with application (maximum 50 words).
5. Artist must include S.A.S.E. for notification.

Awards / Publicity

1. Juror will grant 4 cash awards and may also award any number of merit awards with no cash value.
2. Accepted artists are encouraged to provide 5" x 7" photographs for news publications. Photos for newspapers will not be returned.
3. Biography/resumé to be submitted by all accepted artists.
4. SCAL will produce a CD with 72-dpi images of all accepted works, available for purchase. Proceeds will support future SCAL fiber arts exhibits.

Shipped Entries: Specific instructions will be included with acceptance notification. **Handling cost will be \$20 per piece.** Artist is responsible for return and return cost.
